Dear Senators Carper and Scott and Representatives Blumenauer and Wenstrup:

On behalf of [Moving Health Home](#), I am writing to share our deep appreciation for your leadership in advancing innovative, patient-focused hospital at home models of care, which we strongly believe is the future of health care. As a result of your efforts, bipartisan, bicameral legislation was enacted into law. The *Hospital Inpatient Services Modernization Act* (S.3792/H.R.7053) extends the important Acute Hospital Care at Home (AHCAH) waiver for two years, allowing patients needing acute-level care, and their caregivers, to continue to have access to these services in the home.

By temporarily extending the AHCAH waiver, participating programs now have the predictability and stability they need for their patients and providers. In tandem, it will allow for additional data collection to inform Congress on important considerations to permanently expand access to home-based care.

Thanks to your leadership and support, innovative home-based care delivery models will be able to continue expanding and enhancing their programs and meeting patients' needs in ways that will never be possible in an institutional setting. We may now start to build the bridge from successful implementation during COVID-19 to the post-pandemic experience.

We look forward to continuing our work together to expand access to care in the home for all Americans. Thank you again for your leadership and coordination with Moving Health Home and the many likeminded stakeholders.
